Course structure

Participants will be invited to a web-based course portal. The course will start with a live-streamed welcome event. - Welcome session; introduction to the course, presentation of SKB's experts, instructions on how to use the course portal.

- End of course; summary and short topical presentations based on discussions in the forum, open to further questions.
